Prof. Shiv singh shared his concerns regarding intership issues


Prof. S.C. Gauri highlighted his institution's mechanism to carry process with minimum resources

Prof. R.K. Vaidya briefed panellists on various innovative measures like online valuation OMR Sheeds and digitisation done at different levels in the examination system.




This panel discussion was a joint collaboration of IQAC and Autonomous examination cell of the college


